Dr. Russell's current research interests center on international comparative indicators for the science, engineering and technology labor force, focused on participation of underserved groups; the development of appropriate institutional research strategies for evaluating institutional performance around the world; and providing training and consulting services to education and service delivery organizations for data-driven proposal development, planning, program development, and evaluation.

Dr. Russell received his Ph.D. in Sociology of Science/Social and Organizational theory from Southern Illinois University. He has published, edited, and presented numerous articles, books, monographs, and papers.
